








Searching for e-resources


Tip: Logging into your Library catalogue account first, using your Fellows' Platform login, means you can access all the Society's e-resources directly through the catalogue. You will not need to log in again.



You can access an article by either clicking the direct URL or 'Full Text Finder' / 'View record in ...' (some resources will only show this option).

As long as you are logged in, you will be taken to the article on an external publisher's / content provider's website.


