

## Searching for printed material and e-resources

To change your search from the Library catalogue to 'All resources' (including electronic articles), click the drop-down menu.

The menu also has some search filters, such as Title, Author and Series.

Advanced Search will give you further options to refine your search.

Direct links to other catalogues, help guides and e-journals.

If you are not logged in to your Library account, you will be asked to log in when clicking on a link to a subscription e-resource, such as JSTOR.

**Your login for the catalogue is the same as your Fellows' Platform login.**

## Welcome to the Society of Antiquaries Library Catalogue.

Fellows, Affiliate Members and SCONUL users: please [click here to log in](#) to your Library account. The Fellows' login includes access to all subscription e-resources.

Our new Library catalogue has two main search options:

- **Library catalogue:** This will retrieve the books and journals in the Burlington House Library collection.
- **All resources:** This will retrieve articles and e-books from the Library's subscribed e-journals and databases and from a selection of open access sources, as well as the books and journals in the library collection. Following the link in the records will take you to the relevant article or ebook or book.

Use the search pull-down menu to switch between these options.

New features of the catalogue include:

- **Placing a hold:** If you place a hold on a book that is available in the Library staff will retrieve it for you and make it available for you to pickup or to consult in the Library. Look out for the *Place a hold* link in records.
- **Renewing books:** See a list of books that you have out on loan and **renew them online**.
- **Purchase suggestions:** **Suggest a book** for purchase.
- **Photocopy request:** Request a photocopy of a book or chapter. Look out for the *photocopying request* links.

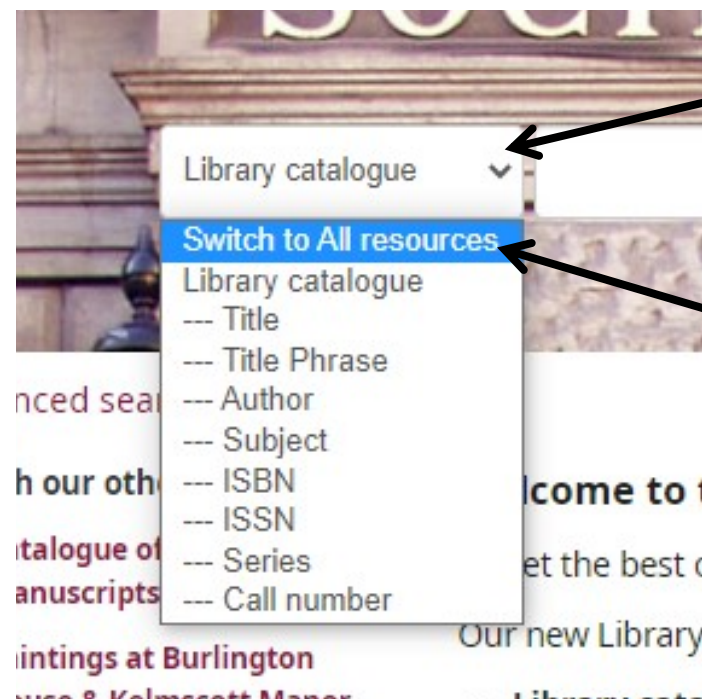

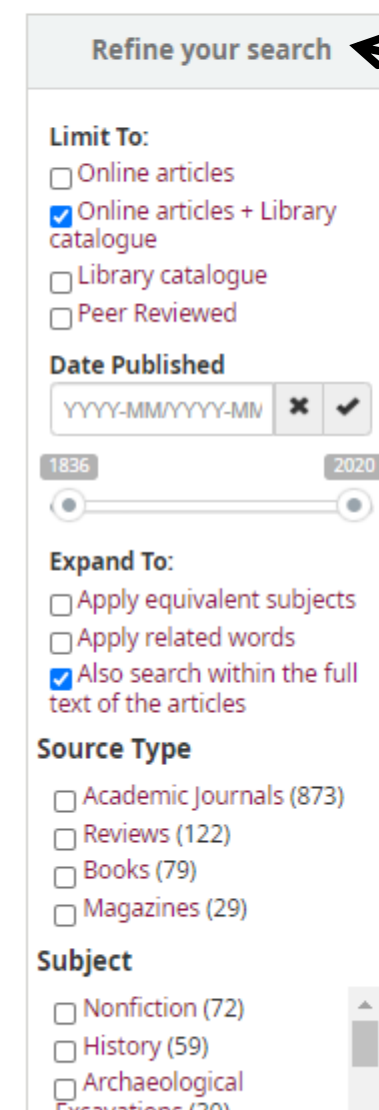
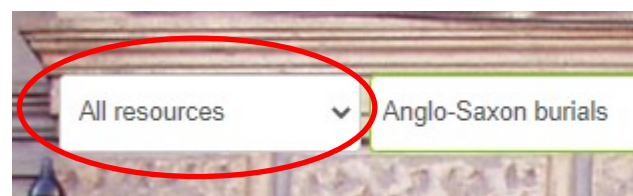
Log in to your account

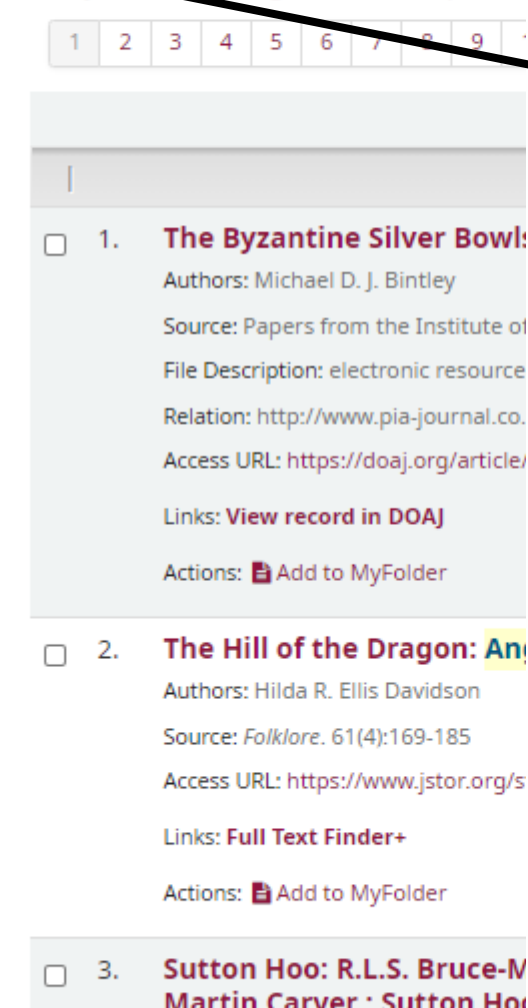
To search across everything
